**PURPOSE:** This instruction established responsibilities, policies and procedures concerning Foreign Broadcast Information Services (FBIS) activities in Japan.

**SUMMARY OF CHANGES:** This instruction constitutes the re-issuance of an earlier version, which was inadvertently rescinded.

1. Scope. Applicable to all DoD organizations, agencies, activities, and personnel under the control of the Commander, U.S. Pacific Commander, who are in Japan under the provisions of the "Agreement under Article VI of the Treaty of Mutual Cooperation and Security between the U.S. and Japan, Regarding Facilities and Areas and Status of U.S. Armed Forces in Japan.

2. **General.** The Foreign Broadcast Information Service (FBIS) bureaus in Japan are assigned to Headquarters, U.S. Forces, Japan (USFJ) for the purpose of reporting and coordination. Administration and support will be in accordance with existing U.S. forces directives or mutual support agreements with the military component command concerned.

3. Mission. FBIS is responsible for the acquisition and dissemination of the information and reports pertaining to foreign broadcasts that concern the United States and the mission of USFJ.
