PURPOSE. Establishes a United States Forces, Japan (USFJ) Chaplains' Committee.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES: Updated to new format.

1. General: The USFJ Chaplain Advisor will advise the Commander, USFJ on religious activities and matters of morale as they affect the religious life of personnel of the component commands in Japan, after coordination with committee members when appropriate. The committee will coordinate such items as: retreats, visiting civilian clergymen on special missions under the auspices of the Armed Forces Joint Chaplains' Board, united efforts in Japan, and other matters as referred to it. The committee will establish its own rules of procedures to be followed at committee meetings and may form such subcommittees and panels as it considers necessary to fulfill its responsibilities.

2. Procedures:

2.1. The USFJ Chaplains' Committee will be composed of the following members:

Staff Chaplain for USFJ, USAFJ/5 AF, 374 AW
Force Chaplain for HQ, US Naval Forces, Japan
Staff Chaplain for HQ, US Army, Japan
Staff Chaplain for 3rd Marine Expeditionary Force (III MEF)

2.2. The committee will meet at the call of the chairman to consider matters which may be referred to it by the commander, USFJ or which the members feel, as a matter of quad-service concern, should be referred to the commander, USFJ.

2.3. The USFJ Chaplain Advisor will serve as chairman of the Chaplains' Committee.
