LIEUTENANT GENERAL JERRY P. MARTINEZ

Commander, United States Forces Japan

Lieutenant General Jerry P. Martinez is the Commander, U.S. Forces Japan, and Commander, 5th Air Force, Pacific Air Forces, Yokota Air Base, Japan. He is the senior U.S. military representative in Japan and Commander of U.S. Air Force units in Japan

General Martinez was commissioned in 1986 as a graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy. He is a command pilot with more than 4,000 hours in the C-17A, C-5B, C-141B, and KC-135R. The general previously commanded the 62d Airlift Wing, McChord Air Force Base, Wash., overseeing the Air Force's only prime nuclear airlift force. His staff assignments include Deputy Chief of Staff Operations, Headquarters Allied Joint Force Command, Brunssum, the Netherlands; Chief of the Joint Mobility Operations Center at U.S. Transportation Command; Secretary of Defense Corporate Fellow with the DuPont Corporation in Wilmington, Del.; and Inspector General, Headquarters Air Mobility Command.

Prior to his current assignment, he was the Director of Operations, Headquarters Air Mobility Command, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois.

His person awards and decorations include; Distinguished Service Medal (Air Force) with oak leaf cluster Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit with oak leaf cluster, Defense Meritorious Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Air Medal with oak leaf cluster, Aerial Achievement Medal, Air Force Achievement Medal and the NATO Medal.

ジェリー P. マルティネス中将は、横田基地にある在日米軍及び第5空軍の司令官であり、日本にて米軍を代表する高官幹部であり、また日本に駐留する米空軍部隊の司令官を務める。

マルティネス中将は米国空軍士官学校を1986年に卒業と同時に任官。C-17A、C-5B、C-141B、そしてKC-135Rで4000時間以上の飛行時間を持つ最上級操縦士である。ワシントン州マッコード空軍基地の第62空輸航空団司令官を務め、空軍唯一の主要核空輸部隊を監督した。幕僚任務としては、オランダのブルンスム統連合軍司令部運用副部長や米国輸送軍統合機動作戦センター長、デラウェア州ウィルミントンにあるデュポン社における国防長官企業フェロープログラム、航空機動軍司令部の監査官などを歴任。

JASDF to conduct PAC-3 training at U.S. installations in Japan

YOKOTA AIR BASE, Japan – The Japan Air Self Defense Force will temporarily deploy Patriot missile batteries to several U.S. installations in Japan beginning Aug. 29, 2017, to practice and refine their ability to rapidly respond to North Korean missile threats.

The installations currently scheduled to support - Yokota Air Base, Misawa Air Base and Marine Corps Air Station Iwakuni - house both U.S. and Japanese forces and play a vital role in the defense of Japan. The one-day deployments will test the interoperability of U.S. and Japanese forces. Additionally, the training will allow for on-site assessments of firing locations, and provide the JASDF with opportunities to test rapid deployment of their air defense assets.

“Bilateral engagements like this one demonstrate the enduring strength of the U.S.-Japan alliance and the determination of both our nations to address the security challenge posed by North Korea's ballistic missile and nuclear weapons programs,” said Lt. Gen. Jerry Martinez, commander of U.S. Forces Japan. “We welcome these training deployments and look forward to working with our Japanese partners to make them a success” Martinez added.

The PAC-3 deployment training will take place at Yokota Air Base and Marine Corps Air Station Iwakuni on Aug. 29 and at Misawa Air Base on Sept. 7.

on PAC-3 deployment training

- Good morning and thank you for being here today. It is a great pleasure to have joint interview with Lt. Gen. Martinez here in Yokota AB.
- This PAC-3 deployment training intends to enhance JASDF's tactical capability and test its ability to maneuver and deploy PAC-3 battery for its expeditious and smooth operation.
- Having shown our readiness in BMD operations as a result of this training, it will lead to enhance deterrence and capability of not only JSDF but also the Japan-U.S. alliance. Moreover, it will showcase Japan's strong commitment and high capability toward peace and security in the Asia-Pacific region.
- As MOD and JSDF, who bear responsibility for defending Japanese nationals and their peaceful lives, it is the most important to keep up such efforts.
- JSDF will continue PAC-3 deployment training across the country to develop the feelings of security and safety among Japanese citizens and to strengthen the alliance.
