***** Book travel for a Thursday arrival to Narita or Haneda airport. *****

Narita is the first pick up location at approximately 2000. Representative from the bus company will be in the vicinity of the DOD Desk Counter Terminal 1 North Wing with a welcome sign. Bus will then proceed to Haneda (after picking everyone up in Narita) airport at Terminal 3, on the second floor. Pick up area is located upon exiting Japanese Customs, to the left waiting area, near the restrooms and smoking room. Bus will not depart until all MANIFESTED passengers have arrived in either locations.

ETA to Sasebo is 18 hours. Bus will only stop for required change of drivers and ventilation as required by the Government of Japan. Bus will not stop for food services. Recommend purchasing food/drink at the convenience

Recommend a light jacket/blanket/pillow for the ride.

Bus is equipped with a toilet. There is WIFI, but no outlets for charging devices.

ROM Notes

CFAS ROM team will provide/obtain information on ROM rules and exit testing.

Discuss ROM status with command i.e. 90 Day Positive, Working ROM, Limited Releases etc.
